The court finds reason(s) for a dispositional departure, as stated on the record. This departure is pursuant to the following factor(s):

- Stipulation of the parties.

Incarceration

Defendant is sentenced to the custody of Oregon Department of Corrections for a period of 8 month(s).

Defendant may receive credit for time served. The defendant may be considered by the supervisory authority for any form of alternative sanction authorized by ORS 423.478, and defendant shall pay any required per diem fees.

Defendant is recommended for the following program(s) and/or treatment(s) while incarcerated:

- Defendant has served his 8 months incarceration and is not required to serve any more time.

Post-Prison Supervision

The term of Post-Prison Supervision is 12 month(s). If defendant violates any of the conditions of post-prison supervision, the defendant shall be subject to sanctions including the possibility of additional imprisonment in accordance with the rules of the State Sentencing Guidelines Board.

The court recommends as a condition of post-prison supervision:

- Defendant has completed his post prison supervision and is not required to be supervised any longer on this case.

Count # 3, Unlawful Possession of Heroin, is Judgment Dismissal Criminal.


